The TANJA LIEDTKE AWARD 2023

On 30 April rehearsals began for the new dance production, "*People holding things*" (wt), by the creator Daura Hernández García, winner of the Tanja Liedtke Award. This new creation addresses the theme of care in different contexts and perspectives. The first rehearsal phase is based on movement research and musical composition. Prior to this, interviews were conducted with both professionals in the care field and the general public in order to obtain information about different experiences on the subject. The collected material so far enriches the creative process and the development of the piece.
